Sub: Brief note of credential of BN Venkataraman seeking to be an administrator of Sri Ayyappa Sewa Samithi (regd) to be appointed by the registrar/Dy registrar of societies, with respect to complaint of even date.

The credential of Shri B N Venkataraman for the job of administrator:

Following are few points to support the candidature.

- 1. The only secretary during 2000-2001 had printed Annual report complete with accounts statements and all relavent information such as list of annadanam contributors, pedestal diya (vilakku) contributors etc. and also with necessary formalities for change of address, and successfully filing papers within two weeks of conducting AGM at that time. That is only once in the history of the Samithi of 31 years.
- 2. The agenda with Annual report along with audit report etc (in all 24 pages) 2000-2001 of the above said year was printed and circulated along with notice calling for AGM and also filed with the registrar in time. That was the only instance in the history of the Samithi.
- 3. The income generation and growth performance of the samithi is maximum generating over 33% of reserve at that time in just 2 years tenure of B N Venkataraman where as the growth performance under the chairmanship of present president is (loss) -54% during the past 5 years.
- 4. B N Venkataraman is one of the three secretaries to comply ROS obligations, The other two are a) Shri K Rajamani (2002 to 2005) and b) Shri RK Nair (2006) had either left Lucknow are living with old age health problems. Another secretary Shri P Venugopal is a good secretary (in 2006-2007) who completed necessary formalities in preparing papers for AGM complete in all respect and properly drafting minutes of AGM with a good amount of deliberations and also trying to put proposed amemndment but failed to comply ROS obligations.
- 5. B N Venkataraman is the only secretary who had made year by year right from (year 1984 to 2001) statement of accounts and a balance sheet—year ended 2000-2001. to ROS and successfully proceeded with renewal of registration of the then unregistered (by default) society.
- 6. Again B N Venkataraman is the only secretary who had made year by year right from (year 2007 to 2008) correct statement of accounts and a balance sheets for all these years 2006-2013. to ROS and successfully proceeded with renewal of registration of the then unregistered (by default) society.
- 7. The above subpara 6 of B N Venkataraman's effort can be very well compared with the **filthy and incorrect statements filed by Dr B Sekar**, the vice President filed on 15.10.2012 and **wilfully incurrect even in** list of Governing Council for period from 2006 to 2010 which are **still available** in the file of I-75557 with the office of Registrar of Societies (U.P). **This wilfull act of providing incorrect information on the part of samithi, with the master mind of the vice president, Dr. B. Sekar is undermining the role of Registrar of Societies and fraudulently manipulate records contrary to the ones available with the samithi.**
- 8. These are all well explained in one of the earlier complaints and request to the Dy.Registrar(Lucknow mandal).
- 9. Also B N Venkataraman has in his personal possession the Accounts statements and AGM minutes etc for 25 years out of the 31 years standing of the Samithi. Out of the remaining six, four can be extracted from ROS records and other 2 are pertaining non circulation and non filing with ROS to the years of current secretary.

The additional plus point is that B N Venkataraman is computer software specialist in webdesign (html, php and javascript and mysql) and maintaining **two personal websites** and that can be utilized for member domain, committee member domain and public domain for the soft copy option properly instead of personal emails by the secretaries under the chairmanship of Acharya

Shri S G Swaminathan that too without any amendment to rules and regulations, the totality can just viewable only by one personal password. All this sort of software help by Mr. B N Venkataraman and uploading / downloading by **individual member will be made avaible free of cost honorarily by B N Venkataraman.**

In addition to the free servises on website If samithi wants individual email addresses in the personal domain of the website of BNV then that also can be provided but at cost which is at easy reach of with the current pattern of revenue. Such emails within the domain eliminates the restriction of gmail/yahoo etc and other blocking feature of some website by some countries. When the website is active one can view the company email ids. Already some members like employees of sbi do know this concept.

In addition to and/or the above, gateway for subscription and donations can be made online which involve heavy one time cost and a little mainitenace and this will take a long time to come to this option with samithi's secured website to consider this option as the software maintenance for these will be far excess of the current revenue of the Samithi. So this option is beyond the purview of the Samithi till it crosses revenue mark in crores of rupees. If 'Lord Ayyappa' wishes all these may happen any time.

So there is no need to print and circulate Notice calling for AGM and other documents in hard copy way by any secretary (even other than b n venkataraman). In the computer web age and App age soft copy from a designated website is the best option that too free of cost as long as BNV is alive/active/good health and the website administration by website host is renewed from time to time by the administrator sons of B N Venkataraman. Current validity of one site is upto mid 2017.

such information on validity period of any website can be viewed publically albeit some software (plenty are available in market free of cost).
